## Key Design Features:

- Broward County/City of Parkland/Forman Family/Riverglades Elementary PTA cooperative project to enable this once endangered native land to be planned, restored, and open to the public under the 1989 Environmentally Sensitive Lands (ESL) Bond Program
- Broward County Heritage Landmark
- Elevated boardwalk to not disturb existing wetlands
- Post-consumer, recycled-content preferred for construction materials of the boardwalks

## Project Description:

Harris Engineering, Inc. was retained by the City of Parkland to design a new 400' boardwalk system and rehabilitate another existing 1,550' boardwalk system in two City passive park areas. The boardwalk needed to provide options for future seating areas within the pavilion. Adjacent to this project were existing cypress wetlands, pine flatwoods, and an oak hammock which needed protection both during and post-construction. The project was completed on-time and on-budget using materials that were composed of 30% post-consumer content.
